HERITAGE

The Milano-Sanremo was born at the beginning of the last century from the intuition of a group of pioneering "gentlemen drivers" of the time who wanted to provide the first wealthy enthusiasts with the opportunity to try their hand at what could then be defined as a brave ride towards the sea and the spring colours of the Ligurian Riviera. However, it was at the end of the 1930s that the competition reached its peak, before being forced to suspend it during the Second World War. However, this did not prevent it from regaining its former glamour from 1948 onwards, thanks also to the increasing number of spectators who followed the race in those years. HERITAGE "The Milano-Sanremo can claim the exclusive title of the oldest race in Italy, since its

first edition took place back in April 1906. Since then there have been many editions that have followed one another and have consolidated its exclusive title. "Thanks to its format which has remained practically unchanged over the years, the Milano-Sanremo has become a reference point for an increasing number of foreign crews and has also attracted a large number of women, which has led to the creation of a special "Ladies' Cup". The race was finally interrupted in 1973, following the oil crisis, and was revived in 2003 as a historical commemoration, attracting collectors from all over the world who wanted to compete on the famous roads leading from the Lombardy capital to the City of Flowers.

THE XV HISTORIC REVIVAL: INSTANT CLASSIC

After the success of the last edition, the Coppa Milano-Sanremo is reaffirmed in the panorama of the great classic car rally, thanks also to the confirmation of its presence in the Italian Great Events Championship organized by ACI Sport.

For this XV Historic Revival the organisers have set themselves two important objectives from a sporting point of view: the confirmation within the Italian Great Events Championship organised by ACI Sport (opened last year by the Coppa Milano-Sanremo) and the further increase of the number of crews, with the declared intention to further increase the level of competition, without prejudice to the maximum number of cars admitted and the participation by invitation. The route itself will be made even more "technical", thanks to a further increase in special stages, with a view to creating a race format even more exciting than in the past rally. The Automobile

Club Milano will be also in this edition the local automotive authority that will officially support the event and, as mentioned, through its sports body (ACI Sport), will give it a competitive value within the Italian Great Events Championship. Like last year, there will also be the possibility to participate in the so-called "Rendez-Vous", the exclusive Tribute reserved for modern supercars and the most iconic youngtimers built from 1990 to the present day, while the eligibility criteria for the classic race remains unchanged, which will use all 11 groupings provided by the ACI Sport regulations (from the origin to 1990).











THE TERRITORY


This has always been one of the strong points of the Coppa Milano-Sanremo, which is able to renew itself every year, without ever losing its essential link with the route of the historic editions










DAY 1

The first day will start with the traditional meeting at the Autodromo Nazionale di Monza for technical and sporting checks and free laps on the track (TBD). The official start of the event, as usual, will be followed by the inaugural gala dinner in the heart of the city centre, where the event's institutional partners will also be presented.







DAY 2

Departure in the direction of Asti where the crews will stop for a short lunch. From here, through the legendary Colli d'Oggia and Melonio, the crews will head directly to Sanremo and Monte Carlo.











DAY 3

From Monte Carlo to the exclusive Loano Marina where the crews will stop for a short lunch. Here, through the Faiallo and Sassello and the famous "Ruta" which will serve as a prologue to the arrival in Rapallo and Portofino, where the third day of the race will end at the two traditionally chosen venues: the Grand Hotel Excelsior.



DAY 4

From Rapallo towards the famous Passes of Monte Fascet will anticipate the finale stages with an amazing stop for lunch in the splendid Castle of Piovera near to Tortona. The final prizegiving ceremony for the crews will take place in Milan city center inside the headquarter of Automobile Club Milano.
